** The progressive move to so-called 'clean-label' improvers in which enzymes play significant roles in delivering the desired end-product qualities in breads, has significant implications for the preparation (mixing) and processing of dough into bread products. Dough development does not end in the mixer but continues during the processing stages. Re-evaluating and improving process control not only leads to more consistent bread quality but also offers significant opportunities for process innovation and efficiency.*
